GT and MR had attended a meeting with Active Dollar and Muckhart (ADM), Dollar Community Development Trust (DCDT) and Clackmannanshire Third Sector Interface (CTSI) to discuss establishment of ADM as a Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation (SCIO). It had been agreed to pursue this, notwithstanding ongoing delays in the development of Devon Way Sports Park and football playing and changing facilities. It is understood that this is due to longstanding difficulties in relation to interpretation of a Section 75 provision.
